- 3.4 Helping to grow Solas's support base by utilising appropriate speaking engagements to explain Solas's work and to encourage people to sign up as supporters of the ministry.
- 3.5 Playing a full and active role with the rest of the Solas team in working on new initiatives, programmes and opportunities.
- 3.6 Taking advantage of the time and opportunities for personal study and development that will be provided.
