Everybody has a worldview but is it a good one?




Understanding the worldview of the person you're talking with is absolutely vital




Testing Worldviews What about Christianity?



Testing Worldviews How would it look if *everybody* tried to live by the worldview in question?

The church ought to be a 'pilot plant', where man can see in our congregations and missions a substantial healing of all the divisions, the alienations of which man's rebellion has produced ... 
