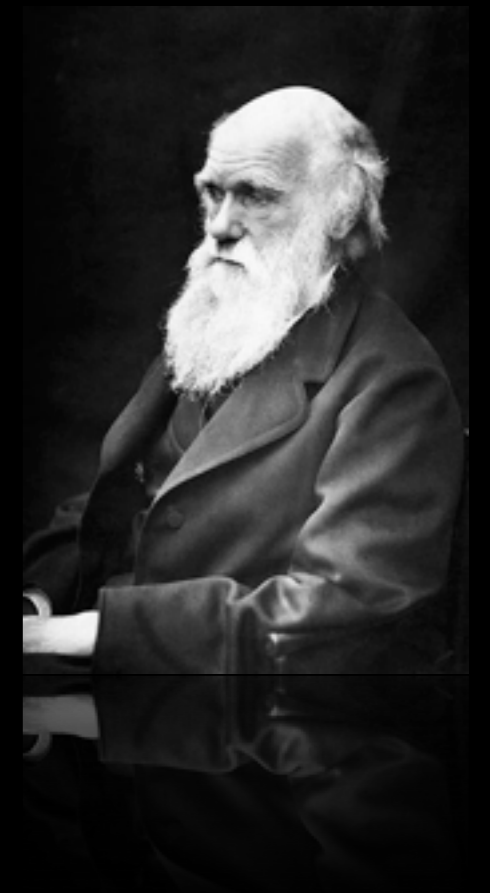




The Basis of Reason
